Personal data

Au Bord du Chemin processes your personal data because you use the services of Au Bord du Chemin and/or because you (have) provided this data to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data processed by Au Bord du Chemin:

- First and last name
- Gender and date of birth
- Address data
- Phone number
- E-mail address
- IP address
- Data about your surfing behaviour across different websites (for example because this company is part of an advertising network)
- Any information provided by you personally regarding your coaching question

Purposes and principles

Your personal data is collected by Au Bord du Chemin during an intake or introductory meeting. Au Bord du Chemin uses this information to contact you, to tailor the agreements and approach to your coaching question and to prepare invoices. It is also used to inform you about relevant products and services and news from Au Bord du Chemin.

Au Bord du Chemin also processes personal data if it is legally obliged to do so.

Automated decision making

Au Bord du Chemin does not make decisions based on automated processing regarding matters that can have (significant) consequences for people. These are decisions made by computer programs or systems, without involving a person (for example an employee of Au Bord du Chemin).

How long personal data is kept

Au Bord du Chemin does not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected or than the (legal) retention period requires.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Au Bord du Chemin does not sell your data to third parties and will only provide it if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. I conclude a processing agreement with companies that process your data on my behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Au Bord du Chemin remains responsible for these processing operations.

Cookies or similar technology

Au Bord du Chemin uses technical and functional cookies as well as analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit the website. The cookies that Au Bord du Chemin uses are necessary for the technical functioning of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and remember, for example, your preferred settings. The website can also be optimized with this. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information that was previously stored via the settings of your browser.

Viewing, modifying or deleting data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Au Bord du Chemin and you also have the right to data portability.
